Measuring for the Best Harness Saddle Size

Firstly you should measure the girth circumference of your horse. All our saddles are made to the following specifications;

Mini Deluxe	77cm	96cm	114cm
Shet Treeless	75cm	105cm	135cm
Shet Deluxe	85cm	105cm	125cm
Pony	100cm	120cm	140cm
Cob	105cm	125cm	145cm
Full	115cm	135cm	155cm
Extra Full	125cm	145cm	165cm

EXAMPLE:

Pony with a girth circumference of 162cm

Pony saddle middle holes (120cm) plus the length of the pony girth 40cm = 162cm

If the measurements fall outside this range, then sometimes a different size girth can provide the right solution.
